Participation

Attending this event in face-to-face is only possible if, upon entering the building or at the gate, proof of

- valid vaccination certificate ([Authorized vaccines in the European Union](#))
- or valid proof of recovery
- or POC antigen test (rapid test, but NO self-test at home) carried out no more than 24 hours ago or a PCR test carried out no later than 48 24 hours (requested by Seminaris Hotel) with a negative result ([Test Centers in Nuremberg](#)).

Please note that ECPE staff will check at the registration desk. Thank you for supporting us to keep all participants healthy!

Participation in the event is only possible if you are healthy!

You are excluded from participating in an event if you have had contact with suspected or positive people in the last 14 days, have been in a [risk area identified by the Robert Koch Institute](#) or have unclear symptoms of the disease in the last 14 days (especially fever and respiratory problems). If you develop symptoms during the event, please contact the ECPE staff and leave the event.

Personal Data

In case of a positive COVID-19 case the personal data (name, private address, mobile phone number, email-address) of all participants must be provided to the local health authorities (Gesundheitsamt). The data will be stored for 4 weeks.

Keep your distance & wear face masks:

Wherever possible, maintain a distance of at least 1.5 metres from other people. If it cannot be maintained, wear a medical face mask covering mouth and nose. In the event room, the seats are arranged at a sufficient distance from other people. Please follow the general hygiene regulations.



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Notices, markings and personnel instructions must be observed! By participating in one of our events, you confirm that you are aware of and comply with this hygiene concept.
